



When to install an irrigation back-out meter:

Granger-Hunter Improvement District will maintain the main meter to your property. However, you will need to install an **irrigation meter** on your property if you have a **grease interceptor**. The **benefit** of having an irrigation meter is that GHID will read this meter as a courtesy and subtract the usage from the main meter so you will not have to pay sewer charges on water used for landscape. This can result in substantial savings. *GHID will only read this meter if you have a grease interceptor.* Our office staff will try to inform you if they ever notice your irrigation meter is no longer working so that you will be able to have it repaired and continue saving money.

Sewer charges are calculated based on samples taken from **your grease interceptor**. It is important for you to conduct regular cleaning maintenance on your interceptor and sampling manhole to help keep your operating costs down.

Your **irrigation meter** must be smaller than your main meter. *For example, if you have a 2" main meter, you will need to install a 1 1/2" (or smaller) irrigation meter.* Irrigation meters can be purchased from Mountainland Supply Company. Please contact GHID if you have any questions regarding the type or size of your irrigation meter.
